## a. Sport Committee Report (Lucy Chang)

-Ski Program: A ski program at Cypress Mountain is in the process of being implemented at Trafagar School. A description of the program has been sent to all class parents to forward. Cypress Mountain is not holding the spot for Trafalgar. The sooner all registration come in the better we stand the chance of getting the spot. It is recommended that all registration forms be sent to the office tomorrow (Oct 13). There is a maximum of 75 registrants. An honorary system (first come, first served) is to be followed. A deposit of 20% of the fee is required with registration. A concern about taking the students out of school (@1:50pm) early was expressed as this will impact instructional time. Communications should be provided to all staff and student/parents fairly. A brief description will be sent to the staff explaining the program and it's intent.

-A basketball program is proposed. The student to coach ratio would be 20 students to 3 coaches. Options are: During PE sessions, or after school. Gymnastics and Tennis programs have already been booked for PE for this school year. The cost would be approx. \$8/student.

# b. Events Committee Report (Yasmeen Strang)

A Trafalgar Halloween Party will be held on October 21st: a pumpkin drive from 2:30pm to 7:00pm and Halloween dance in the gym from 6:30pm to 8:00pm with a cake walk @ 6:45pm and a DJ. This is meant to be a community building event. Tickets will be \$2/child (free for parents). Tickets will go on sale next week and at the event itself. Tickets for the cake walk will be sold at the event (\$2/ticket). Volunteers are strongly welcomed and are needed for this event – an email will be sent out to parents. DJ cost is estimated at approx. \$875 – other DJ options are being researched. A note will be posted in the upcoming newsletter.
