Program Descriptions

GLEE CLUB (class limit: 20)

Under the instruction of Colleen Cotton, the participants will learn a new dance and singing routine that they will perfect for a final performance during the last class.

Please note that the morning and afternoon classes will learn different routines.

MULTI-SPORTS (class limit: 15)

Come out to play a number of different games and sports, like Basketball, Floor Hockey, Soccer... and if the weather is agreeable, the program may move to an outside activity.

The activities will be different in the morning than in the afternoon.

3D COMPUTER GRAPHICS (class limit: 15)

Matt Vogt has taught this course to elementary students and has developed a fun and interesting program. Learn how to create 3D images from "Blender" and to work with animation and computers.

GREEN SCHOOL (class limit: 10)

Plan how to go GREEN through fun activities, cooking with local foods and a tour of community and school gardens. * **This program will involve field trips, so dress accordingly!** *

ARTS and CRAFTS (class limit: 10)

Are you creative? Do you enjoy workings with your hands? Get your mind working and creativeness flowing to make art masterpieces. There is something new every day! We will be exploring different techniques while using different materials.
